* Housing costs, travel expenses, passport/visa fees, meals and personal costs are not included, are location-specific, and are considered to be "out-of-pocket" expenses. Some partner universities and exchange programs charge additional, mandatory fees for services, additional insurance, intensive language supplement programs, etc. Costs such as these are also program-specific and location-specific and are considered to be "out-of-pocket" expenses.

† The "Program Cost" for a Direct Enroll / Affiliate program is the published price found on the Direct Enroll provider's website. Details about what is and is not included with this cost should also be found on the provider's website. Generally, travel, passport/visa fees, meals and personal costs are not included, are location-specific, and are considered to be "out of pocket" expenses. Regardless of whether or not a provider provides international insurance, all UM Study Abroad students are covered by international insurance, included as part of the UM Study Abroad Fee.

‡ This cost (\$792.00) is for a program lasting up to 30 days in length. For a program that is 31-60 days in length, add \$42.00 to this fee. For a program lasting 61 or more days, add \$84.00 to this fee.

§ The "Program Cost" for a UM Faculty-Directed program already includes the UM Study Abroad Fee (including international insurance) and the appropriate UM tuition for the amount of hours being earned. It usually also includes housing and some other "on-location" expenses such as some ground transportation and some activities fees. These details are program-specific.

** "Semester Costs" refer to the normal costs associated with attending UM for a semester. These include, but are not limited to: regular semester tuition, non-resident fee (if applicable), on-campus housing (if applicable), etc.
